To honor Mike, Liquid Garage Co. is sponsoring a scholarship in the amount of \$3000 towards tuition cost for the USFSP Brewing Arts Program. The chosen recipient will demonstrate community service and a passion for the brewing community. Please note that the recipient will need to pay the remaining cost for enrollment in the program. Applications will be accepted November 3, 2023 through January 5th, 2024 and can be used for either the February or August of 2024 classes.

Eligibility:

1. U.S. citizen or U.S. permanent resident
2. Accepted into the Brewing Arts certificate program ([Apply Here](#)).
3. At least 21 years old

Evaluation:

Each applicant will be evaluated in terms of first having a complete package, which consists of the following:

1. Acceptance letter to the USF St. Petersburg campus Brewing Arts Certificate Program.
2. A personal essay which includes discussion on:
 1. Financial need
 2. History/experience in brewing that led to your passion.
 3. Future goals in the brewing industry
 4. Importance and commitment to community service (can be in the form of volunteer or professional work or fund raising as examples)
3. Resume
