ROBBERY INCIDENT

Earlier today, an individual entered the USF Credit Union located at 510 3rd Street South on the USFSP campus and stated to employees that he was committing a robbery. He implied that he was armed with a weapon and left the scene southbound on 3rd Street following the robbery.

University Police Officers located the individual nearby and arrested him without incident. Thomas Michael McDonald, male, white, 68 years old with an unknown address was charged with Robbery and booked into the Pinellas County Detention Center.
