DISTURBANCE INCIDENT/ARREST

Earlier this morning, UPD officers responded to Residential Hall One following reports by a neighbor of a disturbance. Investigating officers determined that the suspect, a former boyfriend, had engaged in an argument and hit a student during the incident. He fled the building prior to the arrival of officers. Officers were able to locate the suspect, who is not affiliated to the university, and arrest him this afternoon. He was taken to the Pinellas County Jail and given a trespass warning from the campus.

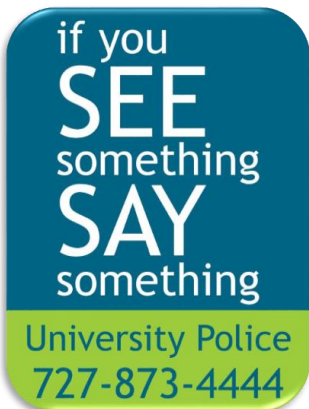
