iCAR: Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. How do I unmute myself?
 - For this event microphones will remain muted.
- 2. How do I turn my camera on?
 - For this event attendee cameras will be disabled.
- 3. How do I change from gallery to speaker view?
 - For this event attendees will not be allowed to switch views between speaker or gallery. Attendees will see what the host wants them to see for the presentation.
- 4. Is this event being recorded?
 - Yes. All sessions and Q & A will be recorded and available from the iCAR website.
- 5. How do I ask a question?
 - Open the chat panel by selecting the chat box on the toolbar at the bottom of your screen. Type your question in the chat box that opens up. Questions will be answered during the Q & A portion of the session.
- 6. What happens when I raise my hand?
 - Please do not use the raise hand function for this event. Instead, ask your questions in the chat where they will be read by a panelist for you, then answered by the host. The question and answer portion will be held at the end of each presentation.
- 7. How do I send a message privately to the host or to the host and attendees?

- To send a message to just the panelist, select the option in the chat box at the bottom of the screen. To send a message to everyone, select that option in the same chat box at the bottom of the screen that includes panelists and attendees.
- 8. Who is speaking right now/ How long will they be speaking/ When is the next break?
 - Questions like these are best answered by checking the agenda which is on the iCAR website (click here). You can also ask in the chatbut in some cases the panelist may not be able to answer the question. Check the agenda for quickest answer.
- 9. How do I take the poll at the end of the breakout session?
 - During the breakout session (occurs day 2 afternoon.) there will be an interactive polling portion for attendees to participate in. Once the poll is launched by the host it will appear in a window on your screen. Answer the poll questions to participate in this session.
- 10. How do I invite someone to this event?
