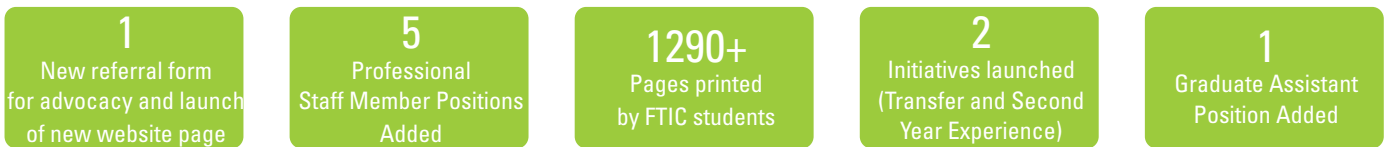

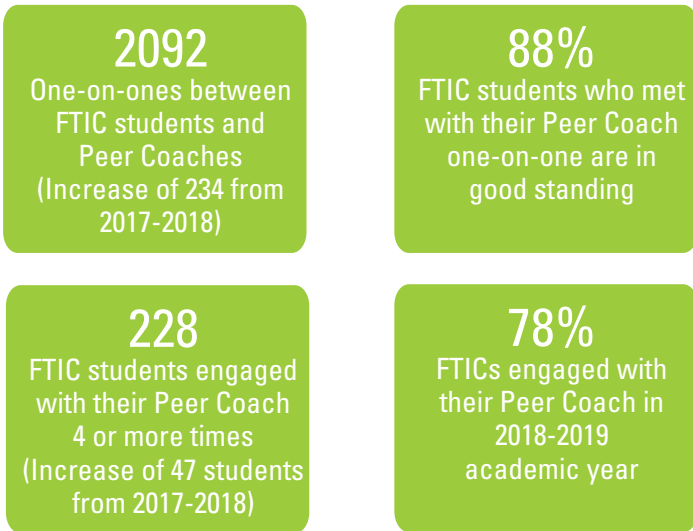
ABOUT COMPASS STUDENT EXPERIENCE

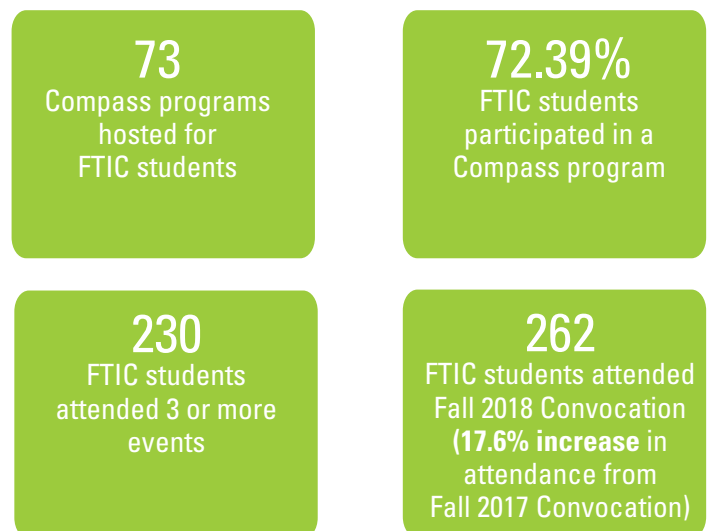

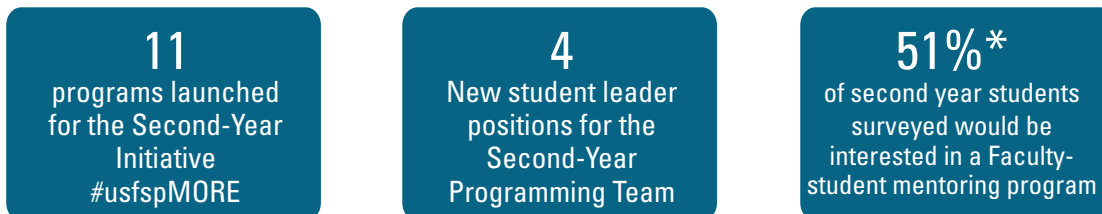
