Class Withdrawal Deadline: Saturday, March 27th

Sometimes passing a class can be a struggle despite all the best efforts. Is your student concerned about their final grade (a C- or below can negatively impact the overall GPA)?

If so, they can consider withdrawing. Dropping a class after the drop/add period has ended is considered a Withdrawal. Students can withdraw with no grade penalty; however, they will not be eligible for a tuition and fees refund. Also, there are withdrawal limits: three for students with less than 60 semester credit hours and 2 for students with 60 or more semester credit hours.

Before making a final decision, make sure your student speaks with the following people:

Professor: What are the chances of passing? What do they need to do to improve? What is the best grade they can hope for?

Academic Advisor: Is withdrawing still an option? If not, how might they make up credits? What happens if their final GPA is low?

Financial Aid Office: How will withdrawing from or failing a course affect financial aid?

Don't forget the withdrawal deadline is Saturday, March 27th.
