Hybrid Blend (HB) Courses are a blend of face-to-face (on campus) meetings and online learning; check course description for explanation	 $50-79\%$ ONLINE	 $\leq 50\%$ ON CAMPUS	 VARIED DATES & TIMES
Primarily Distance Learning (PD) Courses are primarily online learning with minimal face-to-face (on campus) meeting requirements; check course description for explanation	 $80-99\%$ ONLINE	 $\leq 20\%$ ON CAMPUS	 VARIED* DATES & TIMES
All Online (AD) Courses are fully online with no face-to-face (on campus) meeting requirements; check course description for explanation	 100% ONLINE	 0% ON CAMPUS	 VARIED* DATES & TIMES

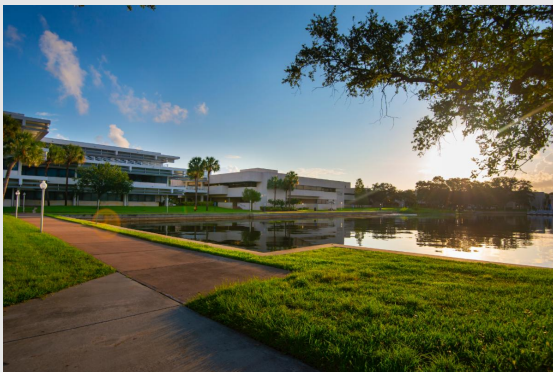
