Next Steps to Become a Bull



Activate your NetID and USF Email Address: If you haven't already, activate your NetID and USF email address at my.usf.edu. Your USF email will be used by all university offices for official communications, so check it often.



Verify Your Contact Information: Sign in to my.usf.edu and navigate to OASIS (Online Access Student information System); navigate to "Personal Information"; verify that your address, telephone number and email address are current; and check your residency status to ensure you are charged the correct tuition rate.



Submit the FAFSA: Need financial aid? Priority deadline to submit your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is before January 1st. Apply at www.usf.edu/financial-aid/apply/



Explore USF Scholarships: Check out additional scholarships by visiting www.usf.edu/financial-aid/scholarships/



Submit Final Transcripts and Test Scores: Before the start of the semester, submit final official transcript(s) and official test scores (sent directly from the testing agency). Official transcripts can be submitted by the institution(s) electronically or delivered in person by the student to the Office of Admissions.



Connect with Your Academic Program: Some academic programs or departments require enrollment confirmation, additional information, or your attendance at a special orientation session to secure a place in the program. 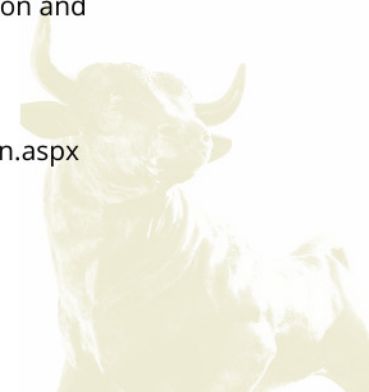
