

PACKING RECOMMENDATIONS

WHAT DO YOU NEED TO KNOW?

During the 3-day, 2-night, off-campus experience, you will be in a bunk style cabin with your peers. While the Windward Success Camp will provide packing recommendations, we highly encourage you to plan accordingly as you know yourself best! The Windward Success Camp will happen rain or shine so be prepared. You will be carrying your luggage and it will be stored for an extended period of time so please make sure that your luggage is self-contained in a zipped bag.

WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT TO WEAR?

Be sure to pack clothes that are comfortable and cool as the weather will be hot and humid! We recommend bringing athletic shorts, t-shirts, and athletic shoes. Overall, pack clothing items that you are comfortable sweating in, and getting dirty as we will be outside and doing various levels of physical activities throughout the camp. We will not have a laundry facility on site so please consider packing enough clothes for 5 days.



SUGGESTED PACKING LIST

- Bed linens or a sleeping bag
- Pillow and pillow case
- Blankets
- Rain Jacket or other rain weather gear
- Bath towel, Hand towel, Wash cloth
- Personal tolietry items: Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Deodorant, Soap/Body Wash, Shampoo, Hair dryer, Brush, Shower Shoes
- 3 pairs of shoes including shower shoes, and one pair of closed-toed shoes (sandals or flip flops will NOT be allowed during physical activity)
- Bathing suit
- Sunscreen (SPF 30 or higher) & Bug Spray
- Flashlight
- Clothing (including a green and gold casual outfit for the Green & Gold Bash)

PROHIBITED ITEMS*

- Alcoholic beverages, and any product/ food containing alcohol
- Tobacco products
- Illegal drugs or substances, including any prescription medication not prescribed to you
- Any sharp objects
- Firearms, weapons or explosives of any kind

**If any of these items are found, it may result in removal from the program and forfeiture of lodging, transportation, and any other amenities provided through the Windward Success Camp. You will be expected to cover costs of any lodging, and transportation back to St. Petersburg, and any damages and/or fines incurred. All USF system students are expected to abide by the Student Code of Conduct.*



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHEN AND WHERE DO I NEED TO ARRIVE FOR WINDWARD SUCCESS CAMP?

Windward Success Camp will be taking place on Friday, August 16 to Sunday, August 18, 2019. The program will occur at the DaySpring Episcopal Conference Center in Parrish, FL. You will need to arrive at the University Student Center (USC) Ballrooms on Friday, August 16, 2019. If you are living on campus for the 2019 - 2020 academic year, you will be able to move into your residence hall room prior to departing for camp.

IF I HAVE A CAR, WHERE DO I LEAVE MY CAR DURING WINDWARD SUCCESS CAMP?

You will be able to park and leave your car on campus. Please make sure you park in the USFSP Garage Levels 2-5 if you are a commuter student, or Levels 6-7 if you will be living on campus. You must purchase your university parking permit ahead of time. Vehicles without a valid permit run the risk of being issued a citation. You will not be allowed to drive to the camp yourself. Transportation in a charter bus will be provided for all participants.

WHAT TYPE OF FOOD IS PROVIDED?

All your meals during the Windward Success Camp will be provided. Meals will be served buffet style and include salad, bar, fresh fruit bar, and a dessert table. Day Springs is happy to accommodate any special dietary needs. Please make sure you notify us of any restrictions on the registration site, so we are able to discuss options and plan accordingly. You are welcomed to bring your favorite snack to share with your peers during camp.

CAN I BRING MY FAMILY MEMBERS OR FRIENDS TO WINDWARD SUCCESS CAMP?

While we understand you may want to share this experience with your family members and friends, Windward Success Camp is for USFSP first-year students only. We will make sure to take lots of pictures so you can share with your loved ones.

WHEN DO WE ARRIVE BACK TO THE USFSP CAMPUS?

We will arrive back at the USFSP campus no later than 4:30 pm on Sunday, August 18, 2019.
