APPLICATION

Qualification: USF St. Petersburg welcomes academically qualified individuals at the time of application with sufficient proficiency in the English language. Applicants may include university professors, school teachers and administrators of social organizations or government officials.

We cannot process incomplete applications, so please make sure all the items listed below are included in your application:

- 1. A completed Global Scholar Academy application form
- 2. Your curriculum vitae (CV)
- 3. Proof of highest degree with English translation
- 4. A statement of interest for participating in the program
- 5. Upon acceptance to the program, a J-1 program application is also required

The USFSP campus is located on beautiful Bayboro Harbor on the shores of Tampa Bay. A bustling downtown is a short walk away. Some of the finest beaches in the country are accessible within a 15-minute drive. USFSP is in the heart of the city's Innovation District, a cluster of higher education, marine science, healthcare, business incubation and media institutions.

PROGRAM BENEFITS

Professional Development & Cross-Cultural Understanding

The program will position scholars to compare and contrast the U.S. and international environments along several dimensions, including educational, cultural and governmental. All scholars will regularly attend seminars and workshops. While scholars may not enroll in classes, they are able to observe classes at USFSP during their stay. These sessions will focus on professional development, cross-cultural and academic exchange, and will help program participants better understand the U.S. education system, the U.S. cultural environment, and other aspects of life in the United States.

- Mentorship All program participants will be assigned a USFSP faculty member to serve as a mentor during their stay at the university. Ideally, this faculty member will belong to the same discipline as the resident scholar, but not always. This will permit the resident scholar to better understand the U.S. educational system as well as to work on research projects based on common interests. Mentors will assist the program participant in receiving permission to attend other lectures, classes, departmental and administrative meetings while they are at USFSP.
- Extracurricular Activities USFSP will arrange a series of activities to help program participants better understand the history and culture of Florida and the United States through visits to historical sites, state parks, local businesses and other places of interest.

PROGRAM DETAILS

Accommodations: Housing for program participants will be arranged and consist of furnished apartments that are on-campus. Each scholar will have his or her own bedroom, while kitchens, bathrooms and other living spaces may be shared. Accommodations are provided only for the program participants. Additional family members will not be accommodated.

Cost: USFSP will accommodate a program participant for one or two semesters. See website for updated program cost.

The program fee includes:

- An on-campus meal plan and a furnished single bedroom in apartment style housing, including most utilities
- Seminars on the U.S. education system, culture and government
- Observation of selected classes on campus, access to the library and other campus facilities
- A USFSP faculty member as a mentor and facilitator
- Sightseeing and field trips in Florida
- Other campus/community events as applicable

The following costs are not included:

- Round trip travel costs to/from USFSP
- Visa fees where applicable
- Personal expenses and food other than the meal plan
- Health insurance (USF medical insurance policy is required without exception and costs approximately \$800/semester or \$1650/academic year)
